Sample spaces and probability measures, random variables and distributions, expectation, conditional probability, independence, and estimation all follow. Optimal portfolio selection coverage is reorganized and the section on the practicalities of stock transactions has been revised. Market portfolio, and Capital Market Theory coverage is expanded. This book, like the first edition, was written so that the print edition could stand alone. At times we simplify complicated algebraic expressions, or solve systems of

linear equations, or numerically solve non-linear equations. Also, some attention is given to the use of computer simulation to approximate solutions to problems. A course in multivariable calculus is not required. The entire text is available digitally from the publisher in the form of a series of Mathematica notebooks, which can be loaded into Mathematica, and which include complete executable commands and programs, and some

additional material.
