 This volume principally deals with perceptions on Jews dating from the beginnings of their emancipation to the Dreyfus Affair. The title in French, and the original title of the colloquium in Hebrew, 'Enlightened Antisemitism' not only reflects the overall anti-religious (anti-Christian and, hence, by necessity, anti-Jewish) sentiments of an Enlightenment figure such as Voltaire, but also refers to those who justified either their philosemitism or antisemitism with erudition: Johann David Michaelis, Antoine Guénée, Charles Maurras, etc. With France as its focal point, the volume also contains essays that treat various perceptions of Jews

during the same period in England, Germany, and Italy.

Interdisciplinary in nature, this collection of essays treats the Jewish question from historical, literary, and sociological angles.

la vingtaine, il était un étudiant sans papiers constamment soumis à des noms péjoratifs au Zaïre, et à la fin de la vingtaine, il était un réfugié sans pays au Swaziland. Avec ce bagage, le traiter de « nègre » dans la quarantaine au Canada n'était pas une insulte qui allait changer sa vie. Mais un racisme sournois allait le priver d'opportunités incroyables dans une société où la vie dépend grandement de la performance financière. Il a alors compris que pour une personne noire au Canada, et qui plus est immigrante, la fenêtre d'opportunité est si petite que non seulement vous avez un temps limité pour la saisir, mais également besoin de compétences

spécifiques pour réussir, “et non sombrer”, dans un environnement hostile. Mais à la fin, ceux qui ont mis des difficultés et des embûches dans sa vie ont fait de lui une meilleure personne, plus forte, compatissante et plus résiliente.

Even when they did not impose aesthetic standards, these regimes tended to favour certain kinds of art music such as occasional works for commemorations or celebrations, symphonic poems, cantatas and choral

settings. In the same way, composers who were more or less ideologically close to the regime wrote pieces of music on their own initiative, which amounted to a support of the political order.
