Arreu del món, institucions privades i públiques posen en marxa iniciatives per tal de donar visibilitat al treball de les dones en la ciència i tecnologia. El nostre sistema universitari, a més, ha apostat per la introducció de la perspectiva de gènere, de forma transversal, als estudis de Grau i de Postgrau que es duen a terme al país. L'objectiu del Congrés, impulsat per les regidories de Polítiques de Gènere i Universitats conjuntament amb representants dels estudis presents al Campus de Terrassa, ha estat contribuir a visibilitzar i posar en valor les aportacions de dones que treballen en diferents disciplines dels àmbits de la ciència, la tecnologia, la salut i especialment d'aquelles escoles presents al campus de Terrassa Universitària. Així mateix, fomentar l'accés i la participació de les nenes, noies i dones en els àmbits científics i tecnològics i integrar la perspectiva de gènere en totes les esferes de l'àmbit acadèmic i educatiu. Des de

l'inici, es va plantejar un Congrés obert a tota la ciutadania, fet que ha provocat que es rebessin més de 65 comunicacions d'arreu de l'estat espanyol, un aforament ple amb gairebé 300 persones assistents, i més de 10 expertes que han moderat els 4 àmbits temàtics que s'han abordat al Congrés. Amb l'edició d'aquestes actes es tanca aquest primer Congrés i alhora es posen les bases per tal que, a partir d'aquest, es treballi per al futur.

Anthropology cannot be limited to situating its object in its immediate context; rather its true subject of study is society as a historical problem. The Nature of Birth and Breastfeeding has as its premise that in order to gain a truer understanding of the human experience, we must examine the way other mammals function during birth, breastfeeding, and parenting. Odent points out some customary procedures that becloud the approaches to childbirth in Western society. On the one hand, privacy and minimal intervention are

key to the ideal birth environment, yet hospitals and the advent of high-tech obstetrics often dictate the opposite, with a result of higher cesarean and morbidity rates. Odent uncovers another irony - the proven need of mother and infant to receive support for an extensive period of breastfeeding may actually be endangered by the nuclear monogamous family structure.
