Even the simplest mathematical abstraction of the phenomena of reality the real line-can be regarded from different points of view by different mathematical disciplines. For example, the algebraic approach to the study of the real line involves describing its properties as a set to whose elements we can apply "operations," and obtaining an algebraic model of it on the basis of these properties, without regard for the topological properties. Functional analysis takes up topological linear spaces, topological groups, normed rings, modules of representations of topological groups in

topological linear spaces, and so on. Thus, the basic object of study in functional analysis consists of objects equipped with compatible algebraic and topological structures.
