Schizophrenia is a serious mental disorder that affects up to 1% of the population worldwide. Cognitive deficits are a core feature of the disorder and strong predictors of social and functional outcome of schizophrenia. Research examining the cognitive abilities of people with schizophrenia revealed that cognitive impairment affects up to 75% of patients across multiple domains including processing speed, working memory, verbal memory, attention, executive functioning, and social cognition. Cognitive deficits often pre-date illness onset, can be present both during the acute and chronic phases of the illness and moreover they show little to modest response to pharmacological treatment at most. According to recent research, structural and functional neuroimaging techniques may be used to better understand the neurological underpinnings of schizophrenia-related cognitive

abnormalities. These methods can give you information about the neural networks that underlie cognitive processes and may help to identify potential targets for cognitive remediation therapy and/or novel pharmacological treatments.

The most significant class of antidepressants marketed in recent years is the selective serotonin re-uptake inhibitors (SSRIs).

Claims of decreased adverse effects (ADRs) and increased safety have led to extensive use of these drugs by non-psychiatrists.

The six SSRIs available in the United States are citalopram (Celexa), escitalopram (Lexapro), fluoxetine (Prozac),

fluvoxamine (Luvox), paroxetine (Paxil), and sertraline (Zoloft).

The primary uses for the SSRIs include unipolar and bipolar major depression and all of the anxiety disorders. However, controlled

trials also support the use of SSRIs in the treatment of other psychiatric disorders including dysthymia, pre-menstrual
