In late eighteenth-century Vienna, a remarkable coterie of five aristocratic women, popularly known as the "five princesses," achieved social preeminence and acclaim as close associates of the reforming Habsburg Emperor Joseph II. They were Princess Maria Josepha Clary; Princess Maria Sidonia Kinsky; Princess Maria Leopoldine Liechtenstein; Countess, subsequently Princess,

Maria Leopoldine Kaunitz; and Princess Maria Eleonore Liechtenstein. During the Viennese social season, members of the group made their way several times each week to the inner city palace of one of the "Dames," as members of the group called themselves. Through analysis of the correspondence of these women and of the published and unpublished commentaries of their contemporaries, this study scrutinizes the activities of this select group of women during the co-regency period (1765-1780) when Joseph shared responsibility with his mother, Maria Theresia, and during Joseph's decade as sole ruler (1780-1790) after Maria Theresia's death—years during which the women enjoyed their special position.

Großherzogin Alexandrine von Mecklenburg-Schwerin, eine geborene Prinzessin von Preußen (1803-1892), und ihre Schwägerin, die Königin Elisabeth von Preußen (1801-1873), schrieben sich ein halbes Jahrhundert lang Briefe. Elisabeth hatte 1823 Alexandrines Bruder, den damaligen Kronprinzen Friedrich Wilhelm (IV.) von Preußen geheiratet. Die sich fremden Frauen wurden Freundinnen. Als Schwestern im Geiste prägten sie das dynastische Familienleben und verteidigten mit ihren eigenen Mitteln die Herrschaft ihrer Häuser über Mecklenburg und Preußen in den revolutionären Umbrüchen des 19. Jahrhunderts. Der ungekürzt edierte Briefwechsel zeigt die mannigfaltigen und einflussreichen Rollen, in denen europäische Monarchinnen agierten: als Mutter, Verwandte und Vertraute; als Erbprinzessin, Herrscherin, Witwe und sogar als Inhaberin von Regimentern.

Aber polnische Aufstandsversuche, Kölner Krawall, das Scheitern der 1. paritätisch besetzten Generalsynode mit Geistlichen und Laien, über die König Friedrich Wilhelm IV. eine christliche Staatskirche hatte einführen wollen, Kartoffelfäule auf den Feldern und der Mangel in den Kochtöpfen kündigten schwierige Zeiten an.
