The fourteen chapters in this anthology
 feature original analyses of contemporary
 German-language literary texts, films,
 political cartoons, cabaret, and other types
 of performance. The artworks display a
 wide spectrum of humor modes, such as
 irony, satire, the grotesque, Jewish humor,
 and slapstick, as responses to unification
 with the accompanying euphoria, but also
 alienation and dislocation. Kerstin Hensel's
 Lärchenau, Christoph Hein's Landnahme,
 and vignette collections by Jakob Hein
 (Antrag auf ständige Ausreise und andere
 Mythen der DDR) and Wladimir Kaminer
 (Es gab keinen Sex im Sozialismus) are

interpreted as examples of the grotesque. The popular films *Lola rennt*, *Sonnenallee*, *Herr Lehmann*, *NVA*, *Alles auf Zucker!*, and *Mein Führer—Die wirklich wahrste Wahrheit über Adolf Hitler* are reexamined through the lens of traditional and more recent humor or comic book theories. The contributors focus on how each artwork enriches four prominent postwar German cultural trends: post-unification identity reconstruction, *Vergangenheitsbewältigung* (including Hitler humor), New German Popular Literature (Christian Kracht's ironic subtexts), and immigrant perspectives (a "third voice" in the East-West binary reflected here pointedly in *Eulenspiegel* cartoons). To date, no other scholarly work provides as comprehensive an overview of the diverse strategies of humor used in the past two decades in German-speaking countries.

The one may be a feeling for novelty, the other is rationally based on experience seeking a better way. - Frank Lloyd Wright Wright was talking about architecture, but the same difference can be applied to analyzing the relationship between standard and vernacular languages in bilingual education; surely we are also seeking a better way to handle bilingual education based on experience. How rationally based our efforts are, is another question. Works on this and similar topics can at times become the scene for very emotional and very moving presentations which sometimes are more utopian than rational. One can perhaps call this a very 'rational' text, because so few of the contributors are members of ethnic subordinate groups. Am I suggesting that minority group members are less rational? Of course not. I am suggesting that it is much easier to be calm, objective and scholarly about the lot of others than about your own. The most salient feature about the bilingual education of vernacular speaking groups is the social and economic exploitation of its members by the dominant group. The papers herein, treating bilingual education from a psychological perspective, agree at least on the issue that an understanding of the social and economic factors underlying bilingual education is crucial for understanding the psychological studies on bilingualism.

Recent work in applied linguistics has expanded our understanding of the rule-governed nature of language. The concept of an idealized speaker-hearer whose linguistic competence is abstract and separate from reality has been enriched by the notion of an actual interlocutor who possesses communicative competence, a knowledge of language which accounts for its use in real-world contexts. Areas of variation previously relegated to idiosyncratic differences in performance have been found to be dynamic yet consistent and lend themselves to study and systematic description. Because

language acquisition involves the development of communicative competence, by its very nature it incorporates variation and systematicity. Second-language acquisition is similarly variable, since interlanguage is subject to the same universal and language-specific conventions. In addition, aspects of the second language have been found to be unevenly acquired and are differently reflected in particular contexts or settings. Yet, despite our expanding knowledge, this variability is only beginning to be treated in much of the second-language acquisition literature. Variation is shown to be relevant to linguistic, social, and psychological aspects of language. It is apparent in the registers and dialects of the target language and in the interlanguage of learners.

Many applications within natural language processing involve performing text-to-text transformations, i.e., given a text in natural language as input, systems are required to produce a version of this text (e.g., a translation), also in natural language, as output. Automatically evaluating the output of such systems is an important component in developing text-to-text applications. Two approaches have been proposed for this problem: (i) to compare the system outputs against one or more reference outputs using string matching-based evaluation metrics and (ii) to build models based on human feedback to predict the quality of system outputs without reference texts. Despite their popularity, reference-based evaluation metrics are faced with the challenge that multiple good (and bad) quality outputs can be produced by text-to-text approaches for the same input. This variation is very hard to capture, even with multiple reference texts. In addition, reference-based metrics cannot be used in production (e.g., online machine translation systems), when systems are expected to produce outputs for any unseen input. In this book, we focus on the second set of metrics, so-called Quality Estimation (QE) metrics, where the goal is to provide an estimate on how good or reliable the texts produced by an application are without access to gold-standard outputs. QE enables different types of evaluation that can target different types of users and applications. Machine learning techniques are used to build QE models with various types of quality labels and explicit features or learnt representations, which can then predict the quality of unseen system outputs. This book describes the topic of QE for text-to-text applications, covering quality labels, features, algorithms, evaluation, uses, and state-of-the-art approaches. It focuses on machine translation as application, since this represents most of the QE work done to date. It also briefly describes QE for several other applications, including text simplification, text summarization, grammatical error correction, and natural language generation.
