Um dos caminhos é inserir nas dinâmicas escolares mais atividades práticas, visitas a exposições e experiências, muitas experiências. Existem até instituições de ensino que procuram apresentar os temas que estão sendo ensinados através de jogos para, depois, explicar a teoria. Essa é apenas uma das formas de planejar a educação que, com certeza, instiga e desperta muito mais a curiosidade. É por essa

nova “tendência” de ensino que podemos encontrar, hoje, no Brasil e no mundo, inúmeras exposições com curadorias impecáveis sobre os mais diversos assuntos: mostras de artes, peças de teatro pedagógicas que explicam, por exemplo, conceitos da física e da química, e exposições que abordam locais ou seres específicos de um determinado período da história. This book is an important and timely contribution to the debate concerning the relation between Heidegger's philosophy and his political affiliations to Nazism. But it is more than that: it is also a study, by the leading sociologist in France today, of some of the institutional mechanisms involved in the production of philosophical discourse. Drawing on his distinctive methods of analysis, Bourdieu argues that philosophical discourse - like all discourse - is the result of an interaction between an expressive drive and the censorship generated by the social field in which it is produced.
